**CELL PHONE POLICY**

Cell phones have become an integral part of society and can be extremely helpful in many situations. Unfortunately, they can also be a distraction in the classroom. In an effort to maximize student learning in the classroom, the following policy regarding cell phones will be enforced:

- Each classroom has been furnished with a cell-phone holder with numbered pockets.
- Each student in the class will be assigned a number.
- Upon entering the classroom, each student will be expected to **turn off** his/her cell phone and place it into the pocket of his/her assigned number.
- Unless directed by the teacher in the classroom, cell phones will remain in the holder for the duration of the class.
- At the end of class, each student may collect his/her cell phone from the holder.

If a student fails to follow this procedure, the student will be addressed individually through the following sequence as needed:

1. A conversation with the teacher
2. A phone call home to the parent
3. A teacher detention
4. Referral to administration
